At the end of February our team had the pleasure of receiving a small team of two students from the YWAM Tyler School of the Bible, Jared from Texas and May from South Korea. This is the school that Beth and I worked with for eight years in Texas. The students have a few outreaches. One is a Spring teaching trip. We got to show them what “Spring” is like in New England.
